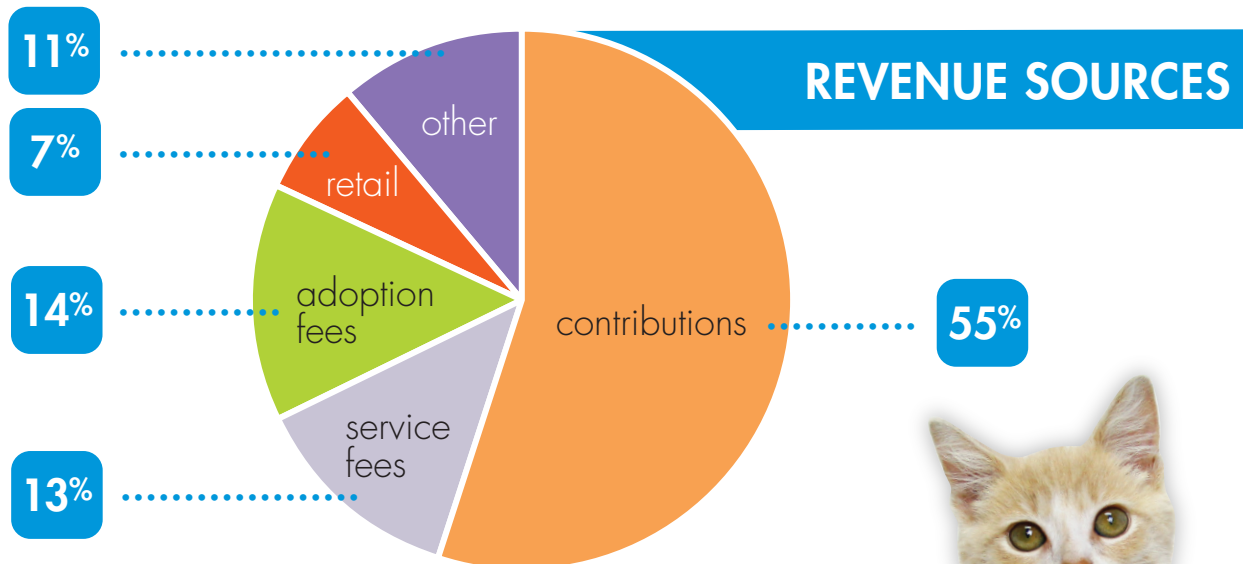
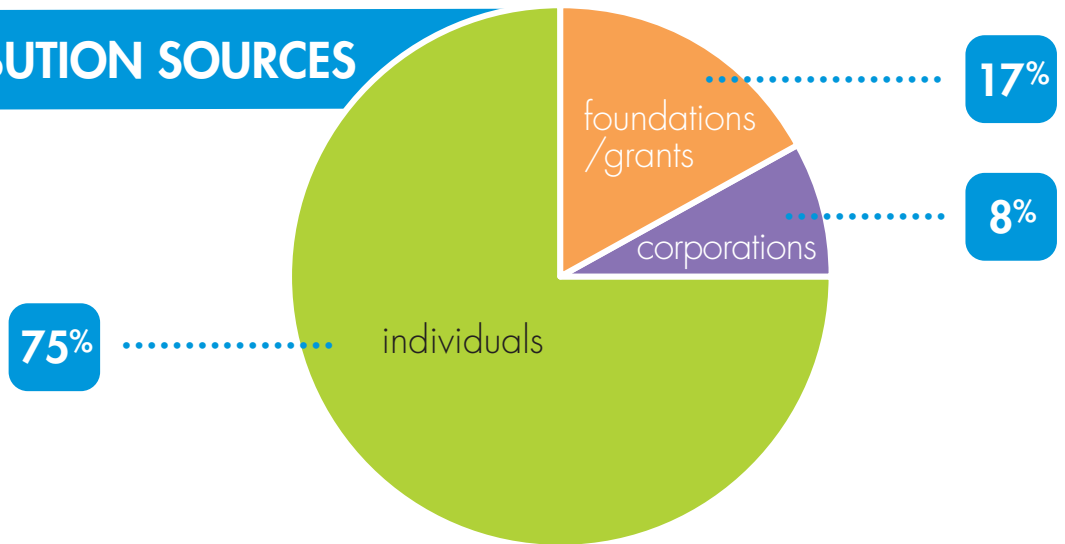
.... served through our **Pets for Life** program, an increase of 57% over the prior year, and 1,000 animals were spayed/neutered.
